

Online Holiday Workshop Terms & Conditions:

Online Workshops (general):

- All workshops and sessions are held ONLINE ONLY via Gallery Lane Cove + Creative Studios Zoom account. No in-person or onsite interactions are permitted.
- No online workshops are to be recorded by teachers, students or staff.
- Online workshops are open to students from any location, but please note classes run on Australian Eastern Standard Time (AEST).
- Parents should provide moderate supervision to students while they are undertaking an online workshop as teachers are unable to provide full supervision to students.
- Although Teachers will provide utmost care during workshop sessions, Gallery Lane Cove + Creative Studios and the respective class teachers cannot be held responsible for any injury or hazardous actions taken by students, as the activities are taking place off-site, outside our premises.
- Minimum enrolments are required for all workshops. If a student has booked into a workshop with an insufficient number of students to proceed, a course credit or refund may be issued.
- Refunds of course fees will only be given if the course is cancelled or a place is not available in the course. We do not offer change of mind or circumstance refunds.
- Full payment must be made prior to commencement of the course.

Art Camps:

- All workshops and sessions are held ONLINE ONLY via Gallery Lane Cove + Creative Studios' Zoom account. No in-person or onsite interactions are permitted.
- No workshops are to be recorded by teachers, students or staff.
- Art Camp workshops are held over a series of sessions (morning and afternoon). Students are to attend each session for their art camp. Sessions cannot be swapped with other workshops.
- Teachers are only able to provide supervision* during workshop hours. Morning sessions run from 10:00am-12:00pm and afternoon sessions run from 1:00pm-3:00pm (or 1:00-2:30pm). Teachers will not be available to students outside of these hours - lunch break supervision is NOT provided.
